WHEREAS, proposals received from JA&E Veterans Staffing, ParCou LLC., and Union Service Company, Inc., were deemed to be non-responsive; and,

WHEREAS, the scope of services will consist of providing "Best-in-Class" janitorial services for the Memphis International Airport and outlying facilities, to include,

but not be limited to, scheduled and unscheduled cleaning in both public and private spaces; and,

WHEREAS, the initial term of the contract will be for a period of one year with four one-year renewal options to be exercised at the Airport Authority's sole discretion, for a potential total contract term of five years; and,

WHEREAS, pricing calculations and proposals were based on current estimated efforts; therefore, final costs over the five-year contract period will fluctuate based on actual services rendered; and,

WHEREAS, the selection committee evaluated the proposals according to established criteria and selected the top six firms for interviews, and, following interviews, subsequently ranked the top three firms in the following order:

- 1. SKB Facilities & Maintenance, Inc.
- 2. Diverse Facility Solutions, Inc
- 3. Flagship Airport Services, Inc.

and,

WHEREAS, Airport Authority management will negotiate a contract for services to be performed with the top-ranked firm; and,

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program, the Airport Authority established a DBE goal of 37% for the full term of this contract; and,

WHEREAS, Airport Authority management recommends that SKB Facilities & Maintenance, Inc., a local DBE, be designated the top-ranked firm;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the

Memphis-Shelby County Airport Authority, that SKB Facilities & Maintenance, Inc., be hereby designated the top-ranked firm, and the President or his designee be hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a contract for janitorial services in accordance with this Resolution, with cost to be paid from the Airport Authority's annual operating funds or any other funds as identified by the CFO.

WHEREAS, the facility will include, but may not be limited to, space for vehicle parking, a customer service building as well as an interior or exterior quick turnaround facility; and,

WHEREAS, the facility will be designed to accommodate potential alternative uses such as public vehicle parking at any point during the lifespan of the facility in order to provide maximum flexibility to the Authority; and,

WHEREAS, the design will include considerations for electrical vehicle charging and solar panels and will require extensive stakeholder (airport, rental car companies, etc.) coordination; and,

WHEREAS, major work phases will be Programming, Schematic Design, Design Development, Construction Documents, Bid Assistance, and Construction Support Services; and,

WHEREAS, work efforts may include geotechnical investigation, site surveying, architectural design, civil design, structural and seismic design, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing (MEP) design, cost estimating, construction scheduling, and other efforts as required; and,

WHEREAS, the Statement of Qualifications of all firms were evaluated by the Selection Committee according to established criteria, and after review, the four firms were interviewed and ranked in the following order:

- 1. EXP U.S. Services, Inc.
- 2. TranSystems Corporation
- 3. PGAL, Inc.
- 4. HOK

WHEREAS, EXP U.S. Services, Inc. was selected as the most qualified firm to provide the requested professional engineering services; and,

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE)

Program, the Memphis-Shelby County Airport Authority (Airport Authority) established a

DBE goal of 26% for the full term of this contract; and,

WHEREAS, the following Programming/Pre-Design Task fees have been negotiated for the professional engineering services:

**Not To Exceed Contract Amount** 

\$ 500,000.00

and,

WHEREAS, the Programming and Pre-Design efforts of this task will determine the ultimate facility design as well as what the associated complete design fees will be; and,

WHEREAS, additional design fees will be brought to the Board for approval as an amendment to this contract at a future date; and,

WHEREAS, Airport Authority's Capital Program Executive Staff, by action taken on December 1, 2023, recommends approval of the negotiated fees for services to be performed by the contractor; and,

WHEREAS, Airport Authority's Capital Program Executive Staff, recommends an Initial Contingency Amount (ICA) in the amount of \$50,000.00 (10%) for the project, which, in accordance with Policy 701, requires approval of the President and CEO and the Board; and,

WHEREAS, EXP U.S. Services, Inc., an out-of-town prime contractor, will utilize four (4) out of town and one (1) local certified DBE subcontractor, which at approximately 26% would total \$ 130,000.00 on this contract; and,

WHEREAS, Management recommends approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Memphis-Shelby County Airport Authority, that the President and CEO or his designee is hereby authorized to execute a contract with EXP U.S. Services, Inc. as herein described, cost to be paid from Customer Facility Charges (CFCs) or other funds as identified by the Airport Chief Financial Officer (CFO).

#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Memphis-Shelby County Airport Authority ("Airport Authority") owns and operates certain real property located at 2491 Winchester Road in Memphis, TN, identified as the Memphis International Airport (Property); and,

WHEREAS, the Airport Authority entered into a Lease Agreement ("Agreement") with the United States of America, by and through the General Services Administration, for the Transportation Security Administration ("TSA") effective April 1, 2016 for a five year term ending on March 31, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the Agreement was amended by a First Amendment to the Agreement, effective April 1, 2021, to provide approximately 4,828 rentable square feet of office and related space located at the Property and to extend the Agreement to March 31, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the parties have continued to operate under the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the parties desire to execute a new agreement for a term of five (5) years; and,

WHEREAS, the new agreement will be a Space Rental Agreement with updates to the demised premises as approximately 5,005 square feet of rented space in the Memphis International Airport Terminal; and,

WHEREAS, the new agreement contains a Termination Clause which states the agreement may be terminated by the Authority, with or without cause, upon thirty (30) days' written notice to the TSA so that the leased space does not become an impediment to any future terminal modernization efforts; and,

WHEREAS, the total gross revenue for the Space Rental Agreement shall be \$4,851,457.50, for the five-year term; and,

WHEREAS, Airport Authority Management recommends approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Memphis-Shelby County Airport Authority, that the President and CEO or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into a Space Rental Agreement with the United States of America for the Transportation Security Administration by and through the General Services Administration as herein described.
